Memorandum of Agreement This Memorandum of Agreement is made between Baba Saheb Ambedkar Technical Educational Society and Spoken Tutorial Project, IIT Bombay (ST-IIT Bombay)

Baba Saheb Ambedkar Technical Educational Society was created to make quality education accessible to all, especially those who are disadvantaged or deprived. They aim to provide affordable technical education, offer a wide range of subjects and options for students to choose from, run employment-oriented courses, provide multiple modes of study, including face-to-face, part-time, and distance learning and democratise education by making it available to all who seek.

The Spoken Tutorial Project was established at IIT Bombay with funding from the Ministry of Education, Government of India (previously MHRD). The use of spoken tutorials is to advocate and popularise numerous Open-Source software and their utilisation.

Spoken Tutorial Project intends to provide an opportunity to conduct IT Skills software training from ST-IIT Bombay to all the 200 – 250 Centres across various states associated with 16 Government Agencies associated with BSATES. Spoken Tutorial charges a nominal User Fee of Rs.29500/year/centre for 2024-25. The program will provide the following benefits to the students and faculties: -

- Participants receive hands-on training through a particular FOSS (Free and Open-Source Software) like Linux, Scilab, LaTeX, PHPMySQL, Java, C/C++, LibreOffice etc. Those who complete the required training hours will be awarded Certificates by Spoken Tutorial Project, IIT Bombay.
- The training enhances students' IT/software skills and employability. A Centre can take 1500 individuals only for the Courses and receive Certificates in a year with a User Fee of Rs. 29,500/year/Centre.

Baba Saheb Ambedkar Technical Educational Society and Spoken Tutorial Project, IIT Bombay do hereby agree to the following broad terms of cooperation:

Baba Saheb Ambedkar Technical Educational Society shall-

- Be a National Level Partner in a Hybrid Model i.e., Partnership of Online Tutorials, certification
 of Spoken Tutorial IIT Bombay and Physical (offline) Training setup under different centres in
 various states under BSATES.
- Help in setting up the infrastructure for this hybrid model at various centres under it.
- initiate marketing to various Govt Departments and Gurudwara Committee and Mobilization of candidates - First three months of implementation of the STP- Hybrid Model.
- Start of Training and Certification: Fourth to Sixth Month by that time (above bullet 3) will
 continue and more centres will join the STP Hybrid Model.
- Hand Hold the candidates and placement support sixth month to the ninth month by that time (above bullet 3 and 4) will be executed simultaneously.

- Have First Pilot project success meeting after 12 months of the implementation of the project to achieve the desired strength of 200 centres and 30,000 candidates.
- Make annual subscription payment of Rs. 29500 per Centre, once 200-250 centres are ready.
- Mr. Manmeet Singh Kapoor will act as Chief Central Coordinator from BSATES and will actively work and coordinate with the Spoken Tutorial team, at IIT Bombay to roll out and introduce the project to all 200-250 Centres across the various states.
- Conduct a Master's training program for Centre Coordinators in each Centre as one of the initiatives under capacity building
- Issue circular to all the Centres to introduce and roll out the Spoken Tutorial software training in all the assigned and designated Centres across the various states

The Spoken Tutorial Project, IIT Bombay shall-

- Work as a mentor for the Centres appointed by BSATES
- Support the training and execution by providing manuals and continuous guidance at the unit level that is the Centre
- Provide guidance and learning path for progressively higher levels of learning through advanced courses
- Provide the know-how and course content, online material, instruction sheets and any other training materials related to the Centres
- Issue Completion Certificates to those who undergo training and qualify for the Online assessment test in Computer systems.
- Provide Participation Certificates to the Individuals who undergo the training and do not take the Online test
- Provide promotional materials like posters, brochures, leaflets, banners etc. to the Centres

This Pilot Letter of Association is valid for 3 months from the date of signing. This period is mutually agreed upon to set up centres and establish our association. Based on the completion of setting up the desired centres and validation of outcome measures, a final Letter of Association will be issued.

Now based on the above-mentioned promise(s), the parties put their signatures on 29/10/2024.
